INTRODUCTION OF BILLS.

By Mr. Brown, the following bills :

Senate bill entitled an Act to provide for the speedy execution and enforcement of chapter 229, of the General Assembly of Maryland, relating to the establishing and maintaining a high school in Centreville, Queen Anne's county, Maryland.

Senate bill entitled an Act to protect fish during the spawning season in the waters of Wye River, within the jurisdictional limits of Queen Anne's county, by prohibiting the taking or catching fish therein during the months of February and March.

Senate bill requiring the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county, on the application of the Board of School Commissioners for Queen Anne's county, to levy for and furnish to said School Commissioners the money necessary to erect and equip a high school building in Centreville, in said county, and procure a proper site for same.

Senate bill entitle an Act to repeal section 172 A, of Article 18, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "Fish and Terrapins," as repealed and re-enacted by chapter 528 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which were read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Brown, Dawson and Lloyd.
