

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Section 9, line 4, insert after word "inlet" the following words: "in sufficient quantities to salt the waters of said bay for the planting, cultivation and growth of oysters in said bay."

Substitute in place of section 16 the following:

"Section 16. And be it enacted, That all Acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act be and the same are hereby repealed."

Add section 17:

"Section 17. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage."
