Senate bill entitled an Act to add two new sections to Article 15 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Kent County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to follow immediately after section 87, and to be designated as "Sections 87 A and 87 B."

Which was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Wootton, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re enact with amendments section 55, of Article 16, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Montgomery County," sub-title "Birds and Game."

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Coffin, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to authorize, empower and direct the County Commissioners of Prince George's county to purchase the District of Columbia and Upper Marlboro' Turnpike Company,

With the following proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In line 1, strike out after "authorize," the words "empower and direct" and insert "and empower."

In section 1, line 8, strike out "empowered and directed" and insert "and empowered."

Which was adopted.

Said bill, as amended, was read the second time.
