and their commercial wealth and prosperity may be recognized and appreciated; therefore be it

Resolved, That the Baltimore Chamber of Commerce respectfully petitions the General Assembly of Maryland, that our State should be fittingly represented by an exhibit which will be fully up to the occasion; that our State may not suffer by comparison; that our mineral wealth, the productiveness of our land and waters, advantages of location and climate, educational features, all the resources that go to make a State great, shall be faithfully and completely pictured.

Resolved, That the Chamber respectfully urges that such a sum be appropriated as will accomplish this necessary result, this Chamber leaving the amount to the discretion of the members of the General Assembly.

Resolved. That a copy of this action be transmitted to the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Delegates.

Which was read, and referred to the Committee on Finance (hereafter to be appointed).
