

Mr. Moore, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill, File No. 472, entitled "An Act to add a new section to chapter 411 of the Acts of 1896, to follow immediately after section 136, and to be known as 'Section 136 A.'"

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Perkins, from Select Committee, reported unfavorably,

Senate bill, File No. 116, entitled "An Act to create a Paving Commission for the city of Baltimore and to define its duties and powers, to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to issue stock to an amount not exceeding five million (\$5,000,000) dollars for the purpose of defraying the cost of the work of said commission; to provide for the submission of an ordinance to that end to the legal voters of the city of Baltimore; and to empower the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to assess the cost of any work of said commission in part, upon the property bounding upon any public lane, alley, avenue, street or highway in the city of Baltimore upon which such work shall be done by said commission, and to collect and make use of such assessments for the purposes of this Act."

Which unfavorable report was adopted.

Mr. Gray, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill, File No. 423, entitled "An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Charles county to issue bonds for the purpose of refunding the bonded indebtedness of said county accruing under section 6, of chapter 546, of the Acts of 1894, known as 'Court House Bonds,' and to levy and collect the necessary taxes for the payment of said bonds and interest thereon."

Which report was adopted; bill read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
