

BILLS RECOMMITTED.

Senate bill, File No. 414, entitled "An Act to authorize, empower, require and direct the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county to build, re build, re-construct, and repair certain bridges over Severn river, etc."

Being on its third reading and final passage.

On motion of Mr. Gadd,

Said bill was recommitted to Select Committee of Senators Gadd, Wilson and Gorman.

The President distributed the following message received from the House of Delegates :

Senate bill, File No. 204, entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 26 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Courts,' to be known as 'Section 44,' relating to the payment of salaries to certain classes of judges after their retirement from office."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."
