The Senate respectfully requests the return by the House of Delegates of printed bill, No. 278, entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 16 of the Code of Public General Laws, of Maryland, to be known as 'Section 198 A, and to follow immediately after section 198 of said Article relating to the powers of Courts of Equity to authorize the mortgaging of lands belonging to estates," the same having been reported unfavorably by a committee of the Senate, and said unfavorable report having been adopted by the Senate. The Senate desires the return of this bill for the purpose of reconsidering the same.
