REPORT.

To the Honorable

The Senate of Maryland:

The Finance Committee of the Senate and the Ways and Means Committee of the House of Delegates, in pursuance of the authority contained in section 23 of Article 95 of the Code of Public General Laws, and an order adopted March 24th, 1904 by the Senate and House of Delegates, examined and destroyed by burning, at the request of the Honorable Murray Vandiver, Treasurer, the evidences of the redeemed and cancelled over-due debt of the State, purchased for the sinking fund, amounting to \$7,400.00 as set forth in Exhibit A of this report, respectfully recommend that the same be spread upon the Journal
