House bill, File No. 446, entitled "An Act to repeal sections 188 to 217 E, inclusive, of Article 3, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Baltimore County,' sub-title 'Roads,' as amended or enacted by chapter 685 of the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at the January session of 1900, and as subsequently amended by chapter 524 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session of 1902, and to enact the following sections in lieu thereof, the whole to provide for a new road system in Baltimore county and the placing of the public highways, sewers and drains of said county and all
