

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Strike out section 2.

In title of bill strike out the words "and the town commissioners of Bishopville, respectively," also strike out the words "and Bishopville, respectively."

Which were adopted.

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Gadd, from Select Committee, reported favorably, with proposed amendments,

Senate bill, File No. 402, "Entitled "An Act to add new sections to the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Anne Arundel County,' sub-title 'County Commissioners,' to come after section 126, as 126 A, 126 B, 126 C, 126 D, etc."

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

At the end of section 126 A, add the following: "Subject however, to the right of appeal from any decision of the said County Commissioners increasing or refusing to reduce any assessment of any person or persons fully aggrieved to the Circuit Court for said county with right of trial by a jury, if so desired."

Which amendment was adopted; bill read the second time and ordered engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Roe, from Select Committee, reported favorably, with proposed amendments,

House bill, File No. 632, entitled "An Act to add two additional sections to Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Caroline County,' new sub-title 'Clerk to County Commissioners,' to come in after section 50, and to be designated as 'Sections 50 A and 50 B.'"
