

BILLS—THIRD READING.

The President laid before the Senate the following bills for a third reading.

Senate bill, File No. 380, entitled "An Act to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland, to sundry gifts, bequest and devises contained in the last will and testaments of certain persons deceased, and also to certain gifts, grants, sales, leases and deeds made by various persons to and for the use and benefit of sundry ministerial persons, religious corporations, educational institutions, denomination or sects, and to certain charitable institutions hereinafter named."
