

highways, sewers and drains of said county and all matters in connection therewith under the care and control of the County Commissioners of said county sitting as a Highway Commission, with power and authority to adopt and carry out such rules and regulations in connection therewith as they may consider necessary, and to be known as 'Sections 188, 189, 190, 191, 192, 193, 194, 195, 196, 197, 198, 199, 200, 201, 202, 203, 204, 205, 206, 207, 208, 209, 210 and 211 of said Article.' "
