

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Amendment to title : Strike out the words and figures "six million (\$6,000,000)" and insert in lieu thereof, the words and figures "two million (\$2,000,000)."

In section 1, line 3, after the word "exceeding," strike out the words and figures "six million (\$6,000,000)" and insert in lieu thereof the words "two million \$2,000,000.)"

In section 1, line 6, after the word "than" strike out "one million (\$1,000,000)" and insert in lieu thereof "five hundred thousand (\$500,000."

In line 5, section 2, strike out the word "six" and insert in lieu thereof the word "four."

In line 6 of section 2, after the word "city" strike out the word "three," and insert in lieu thereof the word "two."

After the word "enacted" in section 10, strike out all of said section and insert in lieu thereof the following : "Provided however, that in lieu of said commission. hereinbefore provided for in section 2. of this bill, the Mayor and City Council may by ordinance authorize and empower the commissioners for opening streets of Baltimore city to perform the duties and functions in this bill heretofore provided for the said commission."

Add an additional section, to be known as "Section 11," and to read as follows : "And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage."
