AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

At the end of section 1, add "subject however, to the consent of the County Commissioners or municipal authorities of said counties and towns."

At the end of the last section add "and that all Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with the Act, he and the same are hereby repealed."
