

## AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In section 9, strike out all after the word "year," in line "5" in section 9 of engrossed bill.

Add a new section to be known as section 13 A, to follow after section 13, to read as follows:

"Section 13 A, and be it enacted, That all Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with this Act, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Moved to amend the title, by striking out all after the word "repeal" in the first line to the word "entitled" in the second line, and insert in lieu thereof the following, "Chapter 160 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-eight."
