AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Line 3, of section 2, strike out the word "gas."

After the word "thereof" in line 3, of section 2, insert the following: "At rates no higher than the rate originally agreed upon by said Chestertown Water Company of Kent county, and at such rates as are now existing and charged by it."

After the word "towns" in line 4, of section 4, insert the following: "And it shall, when it becomes necessary to dig up streets, lanes, alleys, and in any town or village to put such streets, lanes, alleys, etc., in as good condition as they were before the same were dug up and in any way interfered with."
