House bill, File No. 405, entitled "An Act to provide against the evils resulting from the traffic in certain narcotic drugs, and to regulate the sale thereof."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Sanitary Condition of the State.

Also,

House bill, File No. 756, entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Wicomico County,' sub-title 'Roads,' as repealed and re-enacted by chapter 628, Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, January session of 1902, to follow section 129, and to be designated as 'Section 129 A,' providing for the protection of pedestrians and teams at the crossings of the Baltimore, Chesapeake and Atlantic Railroad over certain public or county roads in Wicomico county."

Endorsed: "Read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Brewington, Dashiell and Moore.
