Second the balance, if any, to be paid at the end of each year into the treasury of the State, leaving, however, a balance at the end of each year of ten thousand dollars with the Shell Fish Commissioners, to be applied to the current expenses of his office for the ensuing year. All monies so paid as aforesaid into the Treasury of the State, shall be placed to the credit of a special fund, called the Special Road Fund.

"Sec. 25. And be it enacted, That the land beneath the waters within the limits of Worcester County, be and the same is excepted from the operation of this Act, which shall not be construed to apply in any manner to Worcester County waters.

Sec. 26. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and that all laws of Maryland inconsistent with this Act, be and the same are hereby repealed."

Which was read and considered.
