

Senate bill, File No. 394, entitled "An Act to increase the number of the trustees of the St. Mary's Female Seminary, in St. Mary's County, Maryland."

Senate bill, File No. 380, entitled "An Act to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to sundry gifts, bequests and devises contained in the last wills and testaments of certain persons deceased, and also to certain gifts, grants, sales, leases and deeds made by various persons to and for the use and benefit of sundry ministerial persons, religious corporations, educational institutions, denominations or sects, and to certain charitable institutions hereinafter named."
