

“Be it further enacted, That the said corporation shall have the power to examine buildings, appraise same and their contents, make drawings, plans and inventories, preserve records of the same, audit buildings accounts, adjust losses, make up notices and proof of losses, keep duplicate of insurance policies, of life insurance, fidelity insurance, contract of casualty insurance, contract of indemnity insurance, contract of marine insurance and any other form of insurance contracts, audit accounts of individuals, firms and corporations and do any work for the protection of the assured.”
