Senate bill, File No. 374, entitled "An Act to repeal section 487, of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Allegany County,' sub-title 'County Treasurer,' as enacted by chapter 413 of the Acts of 1902, and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays as amended."

Amend by adding after Section 43 of the following:

Provided, however, that one half of the annual salary of the said Treasurer shall not be paid unto him until an auditing of his books and collections has taken place

Said audit shall be made by an auditor to be appointed by the Governor of this State for such specific purpose who shall not be a resident of Allegany County, and whose compensation shall not exceed two-hundred (\$200) dollars, the State of Maryland to pay its pro rata of such sum according to the tax rate of the County and State respectively and the County Commissioners of Allegany County to pay the balance.
