

RESOLUTION.

Whereas, Section 8, of Article 3, of the Constitution provides, that "in case the number of Senators be hereafter increased, such classification of the additional Senators shall be made as to preserve, as nearly as may be, and equal number in each class;" and

Whereas, Section 2, of Article 3, of the Constitution, as amended by chapter 469 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1900, increased the representation of the City of Baltimore, in the Senate to four members, who were all elected at the same time; and

Whereas, the said amendment to section 2, of Article 3, provided that the election of the Senators should be subject to the classification of Senators prescribed by section 8 of Article 3, of the Constitution; therefore be it,

Ordered, That the President of the Senate shall appoint two tellers, who shall prepare four ballots, equal in size, and alike in form and character of paper, and inscribe on each of these several ballots one of the names of each of the four legislative districts of Baltimore city, as follows:

First Legislative District, Second Legislative District, Third Legislative District and Fourth Legislative District, which said ballots they shall fold carefully, each to itself, and place them thus folded in a ballot box; they shall then prepare four other ballots alike in form and size and character of paper as hereinbefore prescribed; and on two of these they shall inscribe the figure "2" and on the remaining two the figure "4." Then fold each to itself, and place these four ballots thus folded, in another ballot box.

One of said tellers shall draw forth one at a time the ballots having inscribed on them the names of the Legislative Districts of the City of Baltimore, unfold and call out the names of the same: the other teller as the name of each legislative district is called out shall thereupon, correspondingly draw forth the ballots, one at a time from the other ballot box, unfold and call out the figure inscribed thereon, and if the same is figure "2" the seat of the Senator from the Legislative District so as aforesaid correspondingly called shall be
