Chapter 1.

An Act declaring sundry days in the month of February, 1904, to be legal holidays, and providing that Acts and things required to be performed on any of such days may be performed at a later day.

Delivered to Governor Feb. 8th, 1904.

Chapter 21.

An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Chapter 186 of the Acts of 1900, entitled "An Act to fix limit and determine the term of office of the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county that shall hereafter be elected or appointed perpetuating succession to the same and repealing all laws so far as they are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act."

Chapter 2.

An Act to authorize the Governor to appoint a commission to advise as to emergency legislation which may be deemed advisable on account of the great fire in Baltimore city.

Delivered to Governor Feb. 10th, 1904.

Chapter 3.

An Act to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to borrow temporarily such sum or sums of money as may be necessary, not exceeding in the aggregate two millions of dollars, to meet the emergency created by the disastrous conflagration which occurred in the City of Baltimore on the 7th and 8th days of February, 1904.
