An Act to repeal sections 233 and 235 of Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Somerset County,' sub-title 'Roads' and re-enact said sections so as to read as follows."

## Chapter 31.

An Act to provide for additional Justice of the Peace in and for the Seventh Election District of Dorchester county.

## Chapter 32.

An Act to repeal section 107 of Article 17, of the Code of Public Local Laws, of the State of Maryland, title 'Prince George's county' sub-title 'County Treasurer' as enacted by chapter 331 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1902, and to re-enact said section with amendments.

## Chapter 33.

An Act to repeal section 93 (erroneously described as section 23,) of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Cecil County," sub-title "Chesapeake City," as enacted by the Act of Assembly of 1876, chapter 140, section 45, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

## Chapter 34.

An Act to define certain duties of the City Surveyor elected under section 2 of Article 7 of the Constitution of Maryland, to fix his compensation therefor.

## Chapter 35.

An Act to prohibit the laying of railway tracks upon Evergreen Terrace between Fulton Avenue and Grem Lane or Avenue in the City of Baltimore, without the consent of the General Assembly of Maryland.
