

Chapter 72.

An Act to legalize the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland containing the Articles and sections of the present Code, and subsequent Public General Laws now in force as codified by John Printiss Poe, and to make the same evidence in the courts of this State and before all Justices of the Peace of this State and all public officials of this State.

Delivered to Governor, March 11th, 1904.

Chapter 73.

An Act to repeal Section 218 as amended and re-enacted by chapter 370, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1902 and Section 219 as amended and re-enacted by Chapter 318 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1896, of Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Somerset County," sub-title "Revenues and Taxes," and to re-enact said Sections 218 and 219 with amendments.

Chapter 74.

An Act to lay out and establish a new election district in Somerset county, out of a part of Tangier District No. 9, of said county to be called and known as Deal's Island District No. 14, and to provide for the appointment of Justices of the Peace, the enforcement of existing local laws now in force in the territory comprising said new district and to place said district with St. Peter's Dames Quarter and Tangier districts in the allotment of a County Commissioner and Tax Collector for said county as now exists for said district by law and to require the Supervisors of Elections to appoint election officials for said new district.

Chapter 75.

An Act to provide for the building of a Court House in Somerset county and to authorize, empower and direct the County Commissioners of Somerset county to borrow money on the credit of the county for the purpose of building the same and constructing therein the necessary vaults for the preservation of records
