spaces, building lines and the width of sidewalks in said district; for adding to, extending and partly filling the harbor or basin of Baltimore City; and for establishing public wharves and docks, and to provide for appropriating a portion of the General Sinking Fund of Baltimore City and other moneys for the purposes of this Act.

## Chapter 86.

An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Charles County to levy a sum of money necessary to build two school houses for white children, one in the Second Election district and one in the Third Election district of Charles County, title 'Charles County,' sub-title 'Public Schools.'

## Chapter 98.

An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 18 of Article 42 of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Habeas Corpus,' sub-title 'Procedure in Relation to Minors.' as re-enacted by Act of 1900, chapter 306.

## Chapter 99.

An Act authorizing and directing the County Commissioners of Washington County in their discretion to levy and collect annually in perpetuity a sum of money in aid of the maintenance of a hospital to be established in the town of Hagerstown, in said county,

## Chapter 100.

An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Wicomico County to issue bonds for the purpose of erecting a building in the town of Salisbury to be known as the "Wicomico County High School Building" for equipping and furnishing the same to be used for the public school of the said county and to leavy and collect taxes for the payment of the said bonds; and authorize the purchase or condemnation of a lot for the same by the Board of School Commissioners of Wicomico County.
