An Act to repeal section 85 of Article 23 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Corporations" sub-title "General Regulations" as enacted by the Acts of 1892 chapter 109 and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Chapter 102.

An Act to authorize James M. Rudd to build a wharf at Rudd's Landing on the Cecil County side of the Sassafras River.

Chapter 103.

An Act to prohibit the granting of licenses for sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer in Election District Nos. 6, 10 and 12 of Garrett county, Maryland.

Chapter 104.

An Act to repeal chapter 120, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, session of 1902, entitled "An Act to regulate the catching of crabs in the waters of Queen Anne's county."

An Act to add a new section to Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Washington County,' under the new sub-title 'Bills of Exchange and Promissory Notes' to be designated as section 28 A, and to follow section 28.

Chapter 106.

An Act to repeal section 21 of Article 10 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled 'Attorneys' sub-title 'State's Attorneys' so far as the same applies to Washington county, and to add and enact in lieu thereof two additional sections to the Code of Public Local Laws, Article 22, title 'Washington County,' providing a fixed salary for the State's Attorney and abolishing compensation by fees.
