Chapter 137.

An Act to amend the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "County Commissioners," by adding a new section thereto to be known as "Section 133 H."

Delivered to Governor, March 23rd, 1904.

Chapter 153.

An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 5 of chapter 455, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at its January Session of 1894, entitled "An Act to repeal sections 237 to 259 both inclusive of Article 29, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Worcester County," sub-title "Snow Hill," and to repeal all Acts or clauses of Acts heretofore passed by the General Assembly of Maryland with reference to the charter of the town of Snow Hill in Worcester county in conflict with the provisions of this Act, and to re-enact and grant to the town of Snow Hill in Worcester county a new charter.

Chapter 157.

An Act to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to a bequest of \$2,500 with the collateral inheritance tax to be paid by the estate of Miss Willie Swan of the City of Baltimore, to Emmanuel Protestant Episcopal Parish of Allegany County, Maryland.

Chapter 159.

An Act to amend the charter of "Ferry Hill Methodist Episcopal Church South" a body corporate, by granting to said corporation perpetual succession and by authorizing it to hold, own and maintain a cemetery or burying ground and to acquire hold and administer funds for such purposes; and to authorize it to do and maintain all things declared in its certificate
