An Act to amend the charter of the town of Deer Park by empowering the Mayor and Common Council thereof to impose a license tax on any and all kinds of business carried on within the limits of said town.

An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendment chapter 307 of the Laws of Maryland passed at the January Session 1896, entitled "An Act to require the Commissioners of Talbot county to pay annually to the Commissioners of Easton the amount of road tax levied or taxed upon the property within the limits of the town of Easton.
