under the laws of Maryland, extending and enlarging its franchises, and granting to it additional powers and privileges.

An Act to repeal sections 2, 3 and 4 of chapter 203, of the Acts of the General Accembly of Maryland of 1900, relating to wild fowl and game, birds and animals in Somerest Sounty, as amended by the Acts of 1902, chapter 618, and to re-enact said sections, with amendments and to add a new section thereto, to be designated as section 3 A.

Chapter 199.

An Act to create the office of treasurer for Charles county, and to provide for the collection of taxes therein.

Chapter 209.

An Act to amend the charter of the German American Fire Insurance Company, of Baltimore city, by increasing its capital stock, enlarging its powers, and giving its perpetual succession.

An Act to amend the charter of the Union Railroad Company of Baltimore, and thereby to fix the number of its directors, provide for their election and the election of the President of the company.

An Act to refund Joseph Muir a sum of money paid by him to the Comptroller of the Treasury of the State, and covered into the Treasury of State, for license to dredge for oysters with the schooner "Irene," which schooner was wrecked prior to its use under said license.

An Act to add an additional section to Article 81 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 103
