A bill entitled "An Act for the improvement of the public highways of the State and to provide the means therefor, and to require the commission created by an Act of the General Assembly of 1896, chapter 51, to perform certain additional duties."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.

By Mr. Roe,

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments chapter 515 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, 1898, and 367 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, 1902, entitled 'An Act to create and sustain by taxation Public Libraries and Reading Rooms,' chapter 247 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, 1902, entitled 'An Act to promote the establishment and efficiency of Free Public Libraries and Public School Libraries in the State of Maryland, and section 54 of Article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Crimes and Punishment.'"

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Education.

By Mr. Lewis,

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact sections 33, 211, 212, 213, 214, 215 and 216, of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Allegany County,' sub-title 'County Commissioners and Roads,' and to re-enact the same with amendments, and add certain additional sections to said Article 1, sub-title 'Roads,' and to provide for a road directory and a road engineer in Allegany county, and to place all the public roads in said Allegany county under the control of the road directory, to be created by this Act."

Which was read the first time, and referred to Senators Lewis, Betts and Palmer.

A bill entitled "An Act granting and declaring the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the
