Being an Act to prohibit the sale, or keeping for sale, intoxicating, spirituous, vinous or malt liquors, contrary to law; and to provide for a confiscation of such liquors unlawfully handled, together with the appliances used in such unlawful handling."

A bill entitled "An Act to define certain duties of the City Surveyor, elected under section 2 of article 7 of the Constitution of Maryland, and to fix his compensation therefor."
