It appearing that the Hon. Isidor Rayner had received a majority of all the votes in each House for a Senator in the Congress of the United States from this State.

The Speaker of the House of Delegates as Chairman of the Joint Convention of the General Assembly of Maryland, declared that the Hon. Isidor Rayner having received a majority of all the votes in each House for a Senator in Congress, he is therefore duly elected Senator from the State of Maryland, in the Congress of the United States, for the period of six years, from and after the 4th day of March, 1905, to succeed the Hon. Louis E. McComas, whose term of office will then expire.

The Chairman then announced that the Joint Assembly had finished the business for which it had assembled.
