

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS.

By Mr. Gill, a bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8, of chapter 336 of the Acts of 1892, entitled 'An Act to amend the charter and extend the powers of the Maryland Casualty Company,' and to amend the said sections 7 and 8 of said Act with amendments."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Also (by request),

A bill entitled "An Act to appropriate a sum of money for the purpose of strengthening the relations of the State of Maryland with the Southern States, and for the re-union of the United Confederate Veterans if held in the State of Maryland, in 1905."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.

By Mr. McCallough,

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 95 of Article 16 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled 'Chancery,' sub-title 'Jurisdiction.'"

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

By Mr. Gill,

A bill entitled "An Act to enable the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore city to appropriate a sum of money to The Maryland Reunion Company of Baltimore city."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the city Senators.

Also,

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 1, of chapter 316, of the Acts of 1900, entitled 'An Act to define the powers and authority of juvenile institutions and societies.'"
