INTRODUCTION OF BILLS.

A bill entitled 'An Act to add an additional section to Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Corporations,' sub-title 'General Regulations' to follow immediately after section 85 L, of said Article, and to be known as 'Section 85 L, one (1),' of said Article, relating to liability of stockholders to creditors of Safe Deposit, Trust, Guaranty, Loan and Fidelity Companies.'

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

By Mr. McCullough,

A bill, entitled 'An Act to repeal Sections 146 A, 146 B, 146 C, 146 D, 146 D-1, 146 E, 146 E-1 and 146 F, of Article 81, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled 'Revenue and Taxes,' as amended by chapter 120 of the Acts of 1896, and by chapter 313 of the Acts of 1898, and by chapter 26 of the Acts of 1892.'

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.
