REPORTS OF SELECT COMMITTEES.

Mr. Jones, from Select Committees, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the Board of County School Commissioners of Montgomery county, to erect in the Town of Rockville, in said county, a county High School building, and to purchase land for that purpose, and to direct the County Commissioners of said county to pay for the same, and to borrow money for that purpose and to issue the bonds of said county for the money so borrowed."
