

REPORTS OF SELECT COMMITTEES.

Mr. Thomas, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill, File No. 87, entitled "An Act to give powers to the Board of Trustees of the Fifth Regiment Armory, to rent the Fifth Regiment Armory temporarily, and to authorize the city of Baltimore to provide temporary quarters for the Fifth Regiment Infantry, Maryland National Guard."

Whereupon,

Mr. Biddison moved that said bill be re-committed to the Committee on Militia.

Which said motion prevailed by a vote of 9 yeas to 3 nays.

Said bill was therefore re-committed to said committee.

On motion of Mr. Robinson,

Said Militia Committee was requested to report said bill February 17th, 1904, and

Upon further motion of Mr. Robinson,

Said bill was made the Order of the Day for Wednesday, the 17th day of February, A. D., 1904, at 12.30 o'clock, p. m.

Mr. Palmer, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill, File No. 83 entitled "An Act to prohibit the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors and lager beer in all that part of election district number three (3) outside of the corporate limits of Grantsville, Garrett county."

Which report was adopted; bill read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
