Senate bill, File No. 82, entitled "An Act to repeal and re enact with amendments, section 2 and section 12 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1902, chapter 357, entitled An Act to incorporate the Kent and Cecil Light, Power and Railway Company."

Which report was adopted; bill read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill, File No. 81, entitled "An Act to transfer to the Kent and Cecil Light, Power and Railway Company a body corporate, duly incorporated by chapter 357 of the Acts of 1902, the sum of fifty-eight thousand dollars, which by the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1894, chapter 85, was appropriated and transferred to the Elkton and Middletown Railroad Company of Cecil county, and the Elkton and Southern Railroad Company in certain contingencies; and which said sum was transferred by the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1900, chapter 129, to the Cherry Hill, Elkton and Chesapeake City Electric Railway Company of Cecil county, in certain contingencies."
