'Prince George's County,' sub-title Sheriffs,' as amended by the Act of 1900, chapter 530, and re-enact the said section.'

Which report was adopted, and bill read the second time.

Mr. Dashiell, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill, File No. 67, entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 238 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1902, entitled 'An Act to authorize the Commissioners of Somerset county, to pay the costs incurred by Joseph Muir, who was returned without any fraud, by the Judges of Election of said county, as County Commissioner-elect of said county, in his contest with L. Wesely Beauchamp, before the Circuit Court of Somerset county, and the Court of Appeals of Maryland, in which contest the office was awarded to the said L. Wesley Beauchamp, and the said Joseph Muir was compelled to pay the costs of said contest."

Which report was adopted, and bill read the second time.
