ORDER OF THE DAY,

At 1.35 p. m. the Order of the Day being the unfinished business of February 16th, 1904, relating to

Senate bill, File No. 87, entitled "An Act to give powers to the Board of Trustees of the Fifth Regiment Armory, to rent the Fifth Regiment Armory temporarily, and to authorize the city of Baltimore to provide temporary quarters for the Fifth Regiment Infantry, Maryland National Guard."

Being upon its second reading,

The President laid the same before the Senate.

After full discussion,

The favorable report was adopted; bill read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
