A bill entitled "An Act to provide for the issue of — hundred thousand dollars Maryland State bonds for the purpose of completing the addition to the State House in the city of Annapolis, and for the purpose of completing the construction of an annex to the Maryland House of Correction; the State bonds to bear a rate of interest not higher than 3½ per cent. per annum and to provide for a sinking fund for the payment of the State bonds."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

By Mr. Biddison,

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 31 of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Baltimore county,' sub-title 'County Commissioners,' as amended by the Acts of 1900 chapter 474, also sections 32 and 33 of the same Article, and to add thereto a new section to follow section 33 and to be known as 'Section 33 A.'"

Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Biddison, Beasman and Roe.

Also,

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 174 B of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Baltimore county,' sub-title 'Police and Police Stations,' as passed by Act of Assembly of 1902, chapter 428."

Which was read the first time, and referred to Senators Biddison, Beasman and Roe.

By Mr. Robinson,

A bill entitled "An Act for the improvement of the public highways of this State, and to provide the means therefor by distributing amongst the counties of the State any monies derived by the State from the sale, lease or other disposition of the oyster lands under the waters of this State, and to require the commission created by the Act of the General Assembly of 1896, chapter 51, to perform certain additional duties."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Chesapeake Bay and Its Tributaries.
