A bill entitled "An Act to provide for the further publication of the Archives of Maryland."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

Also,

A bill entitled "An Act to create a Paving Commission for the city of Baltimore and to define its duties and powers, to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to issue stock to an amount not exceeding five million (\$5,000,000) dollars for the purpose of defraying the cost of the work of said commission; to provide for the submission of an ordinance to that end to the legal voters of the city of Baltimore; and to empower the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to assess the cost of any work of said commission in part, upon the property bounding upon any public lane, alley, avenue, street or highway in the city of Baltimore upon which such work shall be done by said commission, and to collect and make use of such assessments for the purposes of this Act.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Baltimore city Senators.

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 137 to 142 D, both inclusive of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Baltimore County,' sub-title 'Justices of the Peace and Constables,' as amended and re-enacted by chapter 147 of the Acts of 1900, and to re-enact said sections with amendments, and to add new sections to said Article to be known as 'Sections 142 E, 142 F, 142 G, 142 H, 142 I, 142 J, 142 K, 142 L, 142 M, and to repeal all prior Acts inconsistent herewith.'"

Which was read the first time, and referred to Senators Biddison, Gorman and Beasman.

A bill entitled "An Act to extend the privileges and enlarge the powers, amend and ratify the charter of the Bank of Delmar, Wicomico county, Maryland."
