

ground as aforesaid, between said Big Pool in Washington county and the point of its connection in Mineral county, West Virginia, near Cumberland, Maryland, with the system of the West Virginia, Central and Pittsburgh Railway Company."

Amend section 5, by adding after the words "as hereinafter provided," the words:

"Such waste material however shall be deposited in such places and in such a way that it will not substantially or injuriously diminish or contract the flood area of the Potomac river."

Which several amendments were adopted; bill read second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Also favorably, with proposed amendments,

Senate bill, File No. 40, entitled "An Act to amend the charter of the Western Tidewater Railroad Company, to enlarge its powers and to sanction and authorize the construction by the Western Maryland Tidewater Railroad Company of the route and bridge set forth in this Act."

Whereupon,

On motion of Mr. Biddison,

Said bill was made the Special Order of the Day for Friday, February 19th, 1904, at 11 o'clock, a. m., by unanimous consent.

Mr. Robinson, from Finance Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill, File No. 107, entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Washington county to refund to Mrs. Clara Hamilton, of said county, a certain sum of money for taxes erroneously paid said county commissioner by her."

Which report was adopted; bill read the second time and ordered engrossed for a third reading.

Also favorably,

House bill, File No. 45, entitled "An Act to provide for the deficiency in the payment of Census enumera-
