A bill entitled "An Act to discourage the reckless endangering of life, person, or property."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Roads and Highways.

Also,

A bill entitled "An Act to prevent the obstructing, endangering, or impeding of travel on public roads or highways."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Roads and Highways.

By Mr. Dashiell,

A bill entitled "An Act to provide for the building of a Court House in Somerset county, and to authorize and empower and direct the County Commissioners of Somerset county to borrow money on the credit of the county, for the purpose of building the same, and constructing therein the necessary vaults for the preservation of the records and Court papers of the Orphan's Court and Circuit Court, the County Commissioners, and the Board of School Commissioners, and to issue bonds for the payment of same, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of said county to redeem such bonds and to pay the interest thereon."

Which was read the first time, and referred to Senators Dashiell, Roe and Applegarth.
