

the erection or alteration of any building in Baltimore city, except churches, within one block of the Washington Monument in said city, to a height exceeding a point seventy feet above the surface of the street, at the base line of the Washington Monument."

Which report was adopted; bill read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Dashiell, from Select Committee reported favorably.

Senate bill, File No. 139, entitled "An Act to repeal section 218 as amended and re-enacted by chapter 370 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1902, and section 219 as amended and re enacted by chapter 318 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1896 of Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Somerset County,' subtitle 'Revenue and Taxes,' and to re-enact said sections 218 and 219 with amendments."

Which report was adopted; bill read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Also favorably, with proposed amendments,

Senate bill, File No. 127, entitled "An Act to provide for the building of a Court House in Somerset county, and to authorize and empower and direct the County Commissioners of Somerset county to borrow money on the credit of the county, for the purpose of building the same, and constructing therein the necessary vaults for the preservation of the records and Court papers of the Orphan's Court and Circuit Court, the County Commissioners, and the Board of School Commissioners, and to issue bonds for the payment of same, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of said county to redeem such bonds and to pay the interest thereon."
