216 Q. "The Road Directors shall not be liable in any action whatsoever, growing out of, caused by any of the existing roads in Allegany county being narrower than required by law or growing out of or caused by, their being narrower than they were originally planned; nor shall said Road Directors be required to keep the public roads in Allegany county free from snow drifts, nor shall said Road Directors be liable to any action for damages caused by snow drifts.

216 R. "It shall not be lawful for any person or corporation whose business is that of a common carrier to stop his, its or their vehicles, cars, or engines upon any road-beds or crossings of any public roads of Allegany county, over or across which said vehicles, cars or engines may run for a longer time than is absolutely necessary to take on or let off his, its or their passengers or freight, and such stop shall not exceed in any event a period of ten minutes at any one time; any person or persons or corporation, his or its officers or agents violating any of the provisions of this section shall be liable to a fine of not less than twenty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, to be recovered before any Justice of the Peace of Allegany county, subject, however, to the right of appeal to the Circuit Court for said county. All actions under this section to be brought in the name of the State of Maryland for the use of the Road Directors for Allegany county; and actions under this section may be instituted by any person cognizant of the violation of its provisions.

"216 S. The rights of all persons and corporations who now have actions or cause for actions against the County Commissioners of Allegany county, growing out of their management or control of the public roads in Allegany county, are reserved, and all suits now pending in any of the courts of this State against said Commissioners shall proceed as if this Act had not been passed; and any person or corporation now having a cause of action against said County Commissioners, growing out of their management or control
