Senate bill, File No. 139, entitled "An Act to repeal section 218 as amended and re-enacted by chapter 370 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1902, and section 219 as amended and re enacted by chapter 318 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1896 of Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Somerset County,' subtitle 'Revenue and Taxes,' and to re-enact said sections 218 and 219 with amendments."
