3. And be it enacted, That any thing in the charter of the Bank of Caroline or the act to which this is a supplement, contrary to the provisions of this act, shall be, and the same is hereby respealed.

## CHAPTER 62.

Passed Feb 10, 1826. An act to authorise the levy court of Frederick county to appoint commissioners for the purposes therein mentioned.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,

Commissioners to open streets.

That the levy court of Frederick county, be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered to appoint three commissioners to lay out and make public certain streets, lanes or alleys in and near Middletown, in Frederick county, Maryland: Provided, That the said levy court shall be first satisfied that the said streets, lanes or alleys, are required by the convenience of the inhabitants of said town; And provided also, That the said commissioners shall, before they proceed to open said streets, lanes or alleys, ascertain and determine the amount of damage which may be sustained by any individual or individuals, by means of the opening of such streets, lanes or alleys, and make a return to the said levy court, setting forth the names of the person or persons who may be so entitled to damages, and the amount of such damages; which sum when so ascertained. shall be assessed by the levy court on the assessable property of Middletown, and paid over to the parties respectively entitled to

Proviso.

Shall be nonresidents. receive the same.

2. And be it enacted, That the three commissioners herein before directed to be appointed, shall not reside within three miles of Middletown at the time of their appointment, nor hold real property within said town.
