Not to take Sec. 14. And be it enacted, That nothing contained in this act, shall authorise said company to take private property for their use, without just compensation as agreed upon between the parties or awarded by a jury, being first paid or tendered to the party or parties entitled to such compensation.

To pay to Sec. 15. And be it enacted, That the said company Harford and before they shall be entitled to any of the benefits, privicate & coun-leges or advantages conferred by this act, shall pay to the county commissioners of Harford and Cecil counties, through which the road of the said company passes, or to their proper officer or officers, attorney or attornes, the whole of the State and county taxes which they are or may be legally bound to pay, and which is due from and unpaid by said company in said counties.

Lateral road to extend through Port Deposit.

BEC. 16. And be it enacted, That the privileges through Port the said company shall extend the said lateral road through the said town of Port Deposit, to the northernmost wharf therein, now known as McGrady's stone wharf; Provided, the right of way through said town be granted to said company free of charge.

Double track. Sec. 17. And be it enacted, That the said company shall make a double track on said bridge, if such double track shall be necessary to the general travel over said bridge other than by the railway.

In force. Sec. 18. And be it enacted, That this act shall go into effect from and after its passage.

## **CHAPTER** 139.

Passed April AN ACT making appropriations for the support of the 14, 1853.

Government for the present year.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That for the expenditure in the support of the Government for the present year, ending on the first day of January, in the year eighteen hundred and fifty-four, the following sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated, that is to say: For compensation granted by the Constitution of this State and the laws thereof, to the members of the Senate and House of Delegates, their officers and attendants, (the salaries of
