* SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Incorporated of Maryland, That A. Lingan Jarrett, William H. Dallam, William S. Richardson and Charles Bond, be and they are hereby incorporated in the name of the trustees of the Masonic Hall and Church in Bel-Air, in Harford county, and they and their successors forever, are hereby authorised to take and hold the lot and building thereon, in the town of Bel-Air, in said county, which was heretofore conveyed by the Justices of the levy court of Harford county to John McKenney, Israel D. Maulsby, James Pannell and Samuel Brad-

And be it enacted, That the said corpora- To hold buildtion shall hold the said lot and building in trust for the ing in trust for purposes of a Chutch and Masonic Hall, shall have Masonic Hall. the full control of the same, may regulate the use thereof, and apply the rents, issues and profits of the same to the repair, preservation and improvement of said property, and the said trustee, or survivors or surviver of them, may fill any vacancy that may occur by death, resignation or removal from the county of any member of the corporation.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That said trustees by their corporate name aforesaid, may sue and be sued, contract and make by-laws for their government and action, take and convey property for the purposes aforesaid; Provided, that at no one time shall they hold property yielding a greater annual revenue than three hundred dollars.
